
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



Patents and other intellectual property rights (IPRs) are crucial to the success of most life sciences ventures. As a result, a robust and effective IPR portfolio is often a prerequisite to attracting investment.

Early stage financing for commercial biotechnology continues to challenge SMEs and funders, both private and public, across Europe. The combined pressure of reduced spending power (especially public) but increased demands, funders and policy makers are refining finance for maximum impact on the early stage technologies that strive for maturity. 



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
