What's all about

The Nordic life science story

The Nordic Life Science Days is the major annual life science event in the Nordics. The program, super sessions, workshops, company presentations, exhibition and surrounding activities reflects the flourishing life science sector in the region. Key message is that the Nordic countries is a strong region in life science, both academically and commercially. In the opening session, we have the honor of having Mikael Odenberg, chairman of Karolinska Institutet, Dr. Mikael Dolsten, President Word wide R&D at Pfizer and Anita Krohn Traaseth, CEO of Innovasjon Norge. They will set the stage for the conference, positioning the Nordics in the global life science landscape.

In the Nordics we see a transformation of the life science sector, where developing companies remain with very few employees and relies more on service providers instead of in house expertise. Last year 85% of the clinical stage projects were made by companies with less than 50 employees. To succeed in performing development as a small company, service providers are very important. Many of these service providers are a driving force in developing assays and processes, spending large amount on in house research. A new feature in the program this year is a session where the scientific advancements carried out by service providers are highlighted.

To start off the conference earlier the first day, two new sessions are added. The first is Academic Catwalk, where academic stars from the Nordic countries will give inspirational presentations on state of the art research that could lead to future generations of therapies. This will be followed by a Startup Challenge where startups from the Nordics will pitch their businesses in a competition. We expect the first day will be a relaxed, inspiring day with a lot of fun.

During the week of the Nordic Life Science Days, the Malmö-Copenhagen area will be the host of several affiliated events. On Monday, September 11, H2020 European Health Brokerage Event on Personalized Medicine and Biomarkers will be hosted by The French Institute together with local Nordic partners in Copenhagen. On September 12 in Malmö, a seminar with the title "Advanced Medicinal Therapy Products – A game changer in medicine?" hosted by Nordic and Japanese organizations and another seminar on "Novel solutions in chronic wound healing" by RISE and OxySolutions AS. In addition, there will be more private events hosted by embassies and companies in the region during the week.

Financing of lower-priority clinical trials A new mechanism to fund excess clinical stage projects

Some biopharma companies have built pipelines that offer more development opportunities than their resources allow them to pursue. Promising clinical trials may be moved down the priority list and their execution delayed – resulting in decline of asset value against a fixed patent expiration date. One potential solution is to package complementary trials and bring them into collaboration with investors, CROs or other organizations and fund the execution of these trials outside the biopharma company.
