

Cancellation Policy NLSDays 2021

Individual Registration Cancellation

Registration cancellations must be sent by 1st January 2021, to SwedenBIO Service AB at olivier.duchamp@swedenbio.se to receive a refund (minus a SEK 1,500 ex. VAT processing fee).

Cancellations received after 1st January 2021 and until 31st January 2021 are eligible for a 50% refund of the paid registration fees only.

Cancellations received after 31st January 2021 are not eligible for any refund.

Presentation fees are not eligible for refund after 1st January 2021.

Any eligible refunds will be processed after the event by credit card refund or bank transfer. Please note that no-shows will be billed for the full registration and/or presentation fees.

Payment/Invoice

Credit Card:

New registrants will receive their final invoice right after their registration payment is completed.

Bank Transfer:

New registrants will receive a proforma invoice including our bank details shortly after their registration. To guarantee the rate applied while registering, the invoice must be paid by the 2 next weeks upon proforma reception.

Replacement

Exhibition/Sponsorship Cancellation

Cancellation must be received in writing from the primary contact on file. Signed exhibition/sponsorship booking will be immediately financially liable for a 25% cancellation fee. For a 50% cancellation fee until 31st August 2020. For a 75% cancellation fee until 31st October 2020 and for a 100% cancellation fee until 31st December 2020.
